



THE 6th SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE ON WETLAND MANAGEMENT FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, AUGUST 2023

1.0 EXHIBITION

Space will be available for various sectors/Ministries, organizations, programmes, projects, NGOs and private companies to avail and promote their activities, products and services related to **Wetland Management for Sustainable Development**.

2.0 FIELD EXCURSION

A field excursion will be organized for participants to get on-site experience on Wetland and environment issues.

3.0 REGISTRATION

Registration fees

a): Early Bird Registration Fee

The following rates in categorized groups will be applied per person:

- East Africans: 270,000 TZS
- Non-East Africa: 250.00 USD
- Tanzania Students: 200,000 TZS

b): Late or Onsite Registration

Late registrations for all categories listed above will pay an additional cost of 30% of the early registration fees.

4.0 STUDENT SPONSORSHIP

Target Group: University students enrolled in undergraduate and postgraduate programmes from across the country.

a) Eligible Applicants

Must be Tanzanian enrolled in a university within the country and pursuing a degree course relevant to the conference

b) Selection Criteria for Students

- Must submit an abstract and full paper
- The submitted paper has to address one of the conference sub-themes
- The applicant should submit their applications with full papers not later than 17th May 2023 at 16:00 hrs. All application letters with a scanned Identification card, introductory letters and papers should be sent to conference@nemc.or.tz
- Only shortlisted students will be contacted for funding considerations
- Funding will cover, conference participation fee, public transport and accommodation.

5.0 PAYMENT MODE

a) Important Notice on Payments

- Early bird registration fee will be open from 1st April, 2023 and will be closed on 1st May, 2023
- Tanzanian students must send to NEMC supporting letters from their institutes/universities/colleges and a copy of their student ID.
- East Africans should provide evidence of their identity (i.e., submitting a copy of the Passport cover and first pages (Kenyans, Ugandans, Rwandans, Burundians, Congolese and South Sudanese).

b) Payment for Participation Fee

Following the current Government payment guidelines, before making any payment please ask for a control number from the accounts office by sending an email to conference@nemc.or.tz

Important: Do not make any payment through the traditional method we used previously; currently only government electronic payment Gateway (GePG) is allowed to settle all the bills.
